EVENT: Overnight Camping Trip. Further details at Troop website (www.troop10medfield.org.)

LOCATION: BSA Camp Sayre, Blue Hills Reservation, Milton, MA)

MEET: **Esco Tool Parking Lot** - Saturday, November 17 @ 9:45am (Eat breakfast at home.)

RETURN: Sunday, November 18, around eleven-ish

COST: \$20 (food/gas)

UNIFORM: N/A – Dress for cold (potentially Winter) weather, in *layers*. (You'll get warm hiking, but cold once we stop.) Make note of the weather forecast.

MEALS: Saturday lunch, dinner, and Sunday breakfast.

BRING: Sturdy camping backpack (no school backpacks!!!), cold weather gear, warm water resistant hiking boots, winter sleeping bag, mittens/gloves, hand & foot warmers, extra sox, mess kit, canteen, flashlight, warm hat, rain gear, tent (or use a troop tent), **toilet paper, extra water**, Scout Handbook, Scout Spirit.

- This is a wilderness campout. (No amenities available.) Everything needed must be carried in and out. Pack light. (No toys, electronics, etc.) Refer to pages 224-225 of the Scout Handbook.

NOTE: There is no water available on the trail or campsite. **Everyone must bring and carry an extra 2-liters of water, for troop cooking.** (Fill canteens/bottles at home.) **Also, bring personal supply of toilet paper. There are no latrines on the trail or campsite.** (Refer to page 243 of the Scout Handbook.)
